I. GENERAL INFORMATION

The "Fédération Internationale de Natation" (FINA) hereby notifies and invites all affiliated National Federations to participate in **the 15th FINA World Swimming Championships (25m)** on the following basis:

1. Host, place and dates of competition

The hosts for these Championships, the Abu Dhabi Sports Council and the UAE Swimming Federation, have established the **15th FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) Abu Dhabi Organizing Committee (Abu Dhabi 2021 OC)**, which shall be in charge of the preparation and organisation of the competitions under the control and supervision of FINA.

The events will be held in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates, with the following schedule:

Overview of Abu Dhabi

1. <u>Competition Venue</u>

Competition Schedule

The Championships will be staged over 6 days with heats in the morning sessions and the semi-finals and finals in the evening session.

Ten (10) lanes of the competition pool will be used for the morning heats, while semifinals and finals will be swum using eight (8) lanes.

All morning sessions will start at 09:30, and evening sessions will start at 18:00 Gulf Standard Time (UTC +4).



3. <u>Awards and Scoring</u> (as per rule BL 9.13.1)

- **3.1** Gold, silver and bronze medals shall be awarded to the first three places in both individual and team final events.
- **3.2** Diplomas shall be awarded to all eight finalists in individual events and to the first eight finalists in relay competitions. In swimming relays when preliminaries are swum, diplomas shall be awarded to those swimmers who have participated in the heats and/or the final.
- **3.3** Trophies will be presented to the highest scoring male and female swimmer and the highest scoring national team.

FINA Team Trophy for the top scoring team based on the following points:

Individual using 8 lanes:

Places 1 – 16: 18, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 10, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 points

Relays using 8 lanes:

Places 1 - 8: 36, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22, 20 points.

FINA Individual Trophies for the top scoring male and female based upon the following points:

1 st Place	5 points	2 nd Place	3 points
3 rd Place	2 points	4 th Place	1 point

Individual World Record - 2 points for each new World Record set.

If there is a tie, the FINA Points Table shall be used and a decision made by the FINA Technical Swimming Commission.

3.4 Commemorative medals may be given to all those connected officially with the Championships.



4. <u>Rules</u>

The Championships will be held under the FINA Rules in force at the time of the Championships.

5. <u>Control of Events</u>

Management Committee

The Management Committee shall be appointed by the FINA Executive. (GR 9.4.2).

Jury of Appeal

The Jury of Appeal shall be the Members of the Bureau and the Honorary Members of FINA. (GR 9.3.1)

Commission

A commission shall be appointed consisting of the respective Technical Delegate (Bureau Liaison) and the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Honorary Secretary of the FINA Technical Swimming Committee. **(GR 9.5.1)**

7. <u>Substitution, Withdrawal and Protests</u>

7.1 Substitution

FINA Rule **GR 7** will govern in the event of withdrawals and the cumulative penalties provided therein shall be assessed. The FINA Technical Swimming Commission shall be responsible for checking and keeping records of withdrawals and reporting such to FINA.

Any entered competitor may be substituted by another entered competitor at the Technical Meeting. It is mandatory for the NF Team Managers to take part in the Technical Meeting. (GR 7.1)

7.2 Withdrawal

A competitor or team not wishing to take part in a semi-final or final in which qualification was earned shall withdraw within thirty (30) minutes following the preliminaries or the semi-finals of the event in which the qualification took place. The NF of any competitor who withdraws from the heats/preliminary rounds after the Team Leaders Meeting or from a semi-final or final more than thirty (30) minutes after the preliminaries or semi-finals of the event, in which qualification was earned, shall pay without excuse to the Treasurer the sum of one-hundred (100) Swiss Francs; in case of a relay, the sum shall be two-hundred (200) Swiss Francs. **(GR 7.2)**

A competitor who competed in the semi-finals or final is disqualified for any reason, including medical control, the position he/she would have held shall be awarded to the competitor who finished next and all the lower placing competitors in the semi-finals or final shall be advanced one place. If the disqualification occurs after the presentation of awards, the awards shall be returned and given to the appropriate competitors applying the foregoing provisions. **(GR 7.4)**

If an error by an official follows a fault by a competitor, the fault by the competitor may be expunded. **(GR 7.5)**

7.3 Protests

Protests are possible: (GR 9.2.1)

- (a) If the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competitors are not observed,
- (b) If other conditions endanger the competitions and/or competitors, or against decisions of the referee;
- (c) however, no protest shall be allowed against decisions of fact.

Protest must be submitted: (GR 9.2.2)

- (a) to the referee,
- (b) in writing on FINA Forms,
- (c) by the responsible team leader,
- (d) together with a deposit of 500 Swiss Francs or its equivalent, and
- (e) within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event or match.



If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the event a protest must be lodged before the signal to start is given.

If the protest is rejected, the deposit will be forfeited to the management body of the competition. If the protest is upheld, the deposit will be returned. (**GR 9.2.4**)

8. <u>Swimwear</u>

- 8.1 The swimwear used by the competitors at the 15th FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) Abu Dhabi 2021 must comply in full with FINA rules BL 8 and GR 5 and duly approved by FINA in accordance with the rules and procedures set forth in the FINA Requirements for Swimwear Approval (FRSA).
- **8.2** Before any swimwear of new design, construction or material is used in competition, the manufacturer of such swimwear must submit the swimwear to FINA and obtain approval of FINA. **(GR 5.4)** The official list of FINA approved swimwear is published yearly on September 1st and available on the FINA official website.
- **8.3** In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces. No additional items, like arm bands or leg bands shall be regarded as parts of a swimsuit. (**BL 8.2**)
- 8.4 It is permissible to wear two (2) caps. Both caps must comply with the advertising rules. (BL 7.1.4)
- **8.5** All commercial marking on the swimwear must comply in full with the FINA rule **BL 7**.
- **8.6** The check of swimwear used by the competitors will be performed in the call room prior to start of each event.
- **8.7** The referee of a competition has the authority to exclude any competitor whose Swimwear does not comply with the FINA rules.



9. <u>Advertising</u>

To assist athletes in concentrating on their performance and to ensure that the focus of spectators remains on our sport, FINA aims to ensure that all swimwear and equipment to be used on pool deck at the FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) Abu Dhabi 2021 complies with the latest edition of FINA rule **BL 7**.

All manufacturers sponsoring and/or supplying swimming caps to FINA National Member Federations should produce the swimming caps for the respective Federation in accordance with the design and the specifications in the FINA Handbook.

- 9.1 Identification in the form of logos on swimwear, i.e., swimsuit, cap and goggles, and pool deck equipment, i.e., track suits, official's uniforms, footwear, towels and bags, is permitted in accordance with regulations established in the By-Laws (BL 7). A two-piece swimsuit shall, in relation to advertising, be regarded as one. The name and the flag of the country of the competitor or the country code shall not be regarded as advertisements. (GR 6.1)
- 9.2 Body advertisement is not allowed in any way whatsoever. (GR 6.2)
- **9.3** Advertising for soft alcohol (less than 15% alcohol) and games of chance (i.e., state-sponsored lotteries) are allowed. Advertising for hard alcohol (greater than 15% alcohol), tobacco-based products, vapor-based smoking and sport gambling is prohibited. **(GR 6.3)**
- **9.4** Advertising appearing on swimwear, pool deck equipment and official's uniforms at FINA Championships and Competitions is permitted as follows:
 - a) Any advertising identifications which is not indicated in the regulations is not permitted. In the event that any clothing or other items of equipment contravenes these regulations, the competitor must immediately remove the offending item(s) and replace it/them with clothing that complies with FINA rules. In the event that the breach is not immediately remedied the competitor may be requested to wear attire provided by the event organizer. (BL 7.1.7)
 - b) FINA reserves the right to request Federations taking part in FINA Championships and Competitions to present any advertising identification in this rule for examination and approval of FINA prior to the event in question. (BL 7.1.8)

IMPORTANT NOTE: The final approval of all swim caps, swimsuits, goggles and pool deck equipment is always made at the Championships itself by the technical officials, in the call room prior to each competition swim.



10. Doping Control

- **10.1** As an International Competitions included on the FINA Calendar, the collection of Samples at the FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) shall be initiated and directed by FINA. Any Testing during the FINA Competition Period outside of the Competition Venues shall be coordinated with FINA. (**DC 5.3.1**)
- 10.2 Any Athlete equaling or breaking a World Record in Swimming, as defined in the FINA Swimming Rules, shall be tested immediately after the race, or at the latest, 24 hours after the race. No World Record shall be recognized unless such test returns a Negative Finding based, at a minimum, on the standard In-Competition analytical Testing menu. When a relay team breaks or equals a World Record, only the four Athletes who swam this specific race must be tested. (DC 5.3.3.1)
- **10.3** Should an Athlete equal or break a national record in a FINA Competition and not otherwise be selected for Testing, and the Rules of the Member Federation of the Athlete are similar to DC 5.3.3.2, the Member Federation may request FINA to conduct Testing on such Athlete upon payment of a fee reasonably determined by FINA. (**DC 5.3.3.2**)
- **10.4** Fina Doping Control Rules shall apply.

11. <u>Prize Money</u>

Prize Money at the FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) in Abu Dhabi will be based on the following allocation.

11.1 Prize Money Pool

The total prize money for the 15th FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) Abu Dhabi 2021 is **2'835'000 US dollars**, with 2'295'000 US dollars prize for the best ranked swimmers in individual events, and 540'000 USD for the best ranked relay teams in relay events.

The prize money will be equally distributed to men and women for both individual athletes and relay teams from 1st place to 8th place.

1 st place:	US\$ 15'000
2 nd place:	US\$ 12'000
3 rd place:	US\$ 10'500
4 th place:	US\$ 9'000
5 th place:	US\$ 7'500
6 th place:	US\$ 6'000
7 th place:	US\$ 4'500
8 th place:	US\$ 3'000



11.2 Distribution of prizes in case of tie

In the event of a tie, the total prize money of the tied positions is split between the athletes/relay teams. For example, in the case of a tie in the 1st position, the sum of US\$ 15'000 and US\$ 12'000 will be split equally between the top 2 athletes/relay teams.

11.3 Prize for a new World Record

Prize money will also be paid to the swimmers establishing each new World Record during the programme of the Championships in individual events.

World Records (each) US\$ 50'000.-

11.4 Payment of Prize Money

The prize funds shall be paid by direct bank transfer only.

For individual events, the National Federation of a swimmer winning prize money should inform FINA as to whether the prize money will be paid to the National Federation or directly to the athlete. Prize money for relays is to be paid to the National Federation directly.

The amount of the prize money will be paid net of local taxes or deductions if applicable. Participants/National Federations are solely responsible for any tax obligations in their respective countries.

The Prize Money will be paid by FINA only after receiving all laboratory doping control tests results.

12. <u>Ticketing</u>

Details on ticketing will be provided on the FINA website and the official website of the Organising Committee in due course.

National Federations can request from the OC to purchase tickets in bulk (a minimum of 10 ticket per session). For private purposes, please contact via the official event website.



1. <u>Registration procedure</u>

All Registrations and Entries shall take place through the FINA General Management System (FINA GMS) which can be accessed by <u>https://data.fina.org</u>. National Federations must use their usual login details to access the system. For registration help and assistance please contact: <u>aquaticsdb@fina.org</u>.

Please note that the registration for the 15th FINA World Swimming Championships Abu Dhabi 2021 will open on <u>16th August 2021</u>.

1.1 Preliminary & Final Registration

There will be three successive entry steps to provide information to FINA and the Organising Committee in order to register for the event.

IMPORTANT NOTE: All deadlines will be at 23:59 (GMT) on the respective dates.

The entry steps are as follows:

a. PRELIMINARY ENTRIES

To be submitted through the FINA GMS by 22nd September 2021 @ 23:59 (GMT)

The Preliminary Entry is for the purpose of indicating to the Organising Committee the maximum number of competitors, representatives, coaches, official delegates, medical staff, etc which each Federation intends to register for the competition.

b. FINAL NOMINATIONS (Entries by Name)

To be submitted through the FINA GMS by 2nd November 2021 @ 23:59 (GMT)

The Final Nominations is the final deadline to register all Athletes and Team Officials that includes all relevant data for the purposes of Accreditation and Visa assistance.

After this deadline it will not be possible to register anymore individuals to the event. The number of registrations must not exceed the numbers submitted in the Preliminary Entry.



The data must contain the exact number of named competitors, representatives, coaches, official delegates, medical staff, etc., All requested information must be fully and correctly completed in the FINA GMS. At this date, the NF must also have completed the final room requests (exact number of rooms, dates, etc.) and provide the OC with the complete rooming list via the FINA GMS.

c. FINAL SPORT ENTRIES

To be submitted through the FINA GMS by <u>1st December 2021 @ 23:59 (GMT)</u>

Each Athlete must be registered for the event(s) they will be participating in by this date. No late entries will be accepted. FINA and the OC will use all collected data for the purposes of event registration and accreditation.

The qualification period for all entry times is: 1st March 2019 – 28th November 2021.

1.2 Qualification of Competitors

For the **15th FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) Abu Dhabi 2021**, the FINA Technical Swimming Committee (TSC) has decided in addition to 25m standard times to apply the Long course time standards established for the 19th FINA World Championships 2022. This allows federations to enter swimmers who meet the approved Short course OR Long course standards in qualification meets approved by FINA.

- Qualifying competitions must have been previously approved by FINA and fall within the qualification period of:
 - 1st March 2019 28th November 2021
- All entry times MUST be included in the FINA World Swimming Rankings in order to be validated.
 - 25m entry times will be checked against qualifications standards for FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) Abu Dhabi 2021
 - 50m entry times will be checked against qualifications standards for FINA World Championships 2022 Fukuoka
 - 50m entry times will not be converted
- There is no restriction on an athlete entering with times from both 25m and 50m competitions according to the FINA A/B/U rules
- All entry times will be seeded as per FINA rules regardless of whether the entry time was achieved in a 25m or 50m pool
- Each athlete shall furthermore be eligible to represent his/her country as per FINA Rule GR 2.



a. FOR INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

Rules for Entries for Individual Events (BL 9.3.6)

- **1.** For each individual event at the World Championships, the FINA Bureau will establish Standard Entry Times in two levels: "A" and "B", of which "B" shall be easier to achieve.
 - a) Standard Entry Times can only be achieved in competitions approved for that purpose by FINA.
 - **b)** For each individual event at the World Championships, each National Federation may enter a maximum of two (2) competitors. To enter two (2) swimmers in the same event, both of them must have achieved the "A" Standard Entry Time.
 - c) To enter one (1) swimmer in an event, the competitor must have achieved at least the "B" Standard Entry Time.
 - **d)** Swimmers having achieved only one (1) "A" or one (1) "B" entry time are entitled to enter one (1) additional event. The additional individual event must be in an event where no other swimmer from the National Federation has been entered.
- **2.** At the World Championships, National Federations may enter swimmers who have not achieved either Standard Entry Time as follows:
 - a) With no swimmers who have achieved the "A" or "B" Standard Entry Time: National Federations may enter up to four (4) swimmers, two (2) men and two (2) women.
 - b) With one (1) or two (2) swimmers who has achieved the "A" or "B" Standard Entry Time: National Federations may enter up to a maximum of four (4) swimmers (two (2) men and two (2) women), and with three (3) swimmers who have achieved the "A" or "B" Standard Entry Time, one (1) additional swimmer provided that both genders are represented.
 - c) The swimmers who have not achieved either Standard Entry Time will only be permitted to enter up to two (2) individual events each.
 - **d)** An individual entry for a swimmer without an "A" or "B" Standard Entry Time must be in an event where no other swimmer from the National Federation has been entered.

- The composition of a relay team may be changed between heats and finals of an event. When preliminaries are swum, medals or diplomas shall be awarded to those swimmers who have participated in the heats and/or the final.
- The names of swimmers actually swimming on a relay must be submitted at least one hour before the start of the session in which the event is to take place, in the order in which they are to swim. The names of the swimmers in medley relay events must be listed for their respective strokes. (**BL 9.3.6.8**)

- Each Member may enter a maximum of 26 men and 26 women swimmers. (BL 9.3.6.9)
- The minimum age for swimmers competing in the FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) shall be the same as the minimum age for the FINA World Junior Swimming Championships: Women, 14 years of age, and Men, 15 years of age, on 31st December in the year of competition, except younger athletes may participate in these competitions if they have achieved at least the "B" Standard Entry Time in the respective event. (BL 9.3.6)
- National Federations will enter swimmers and relay teams using the FINA Rankings as the entry time for seeding purposes.



- Please kindly note that:
 - Only valid times included in the FINA Rankings at the date of the deadline for entries and achieved within the qualification period can be accepted as entry times. (BL 9.3.6.6)
 - National Federations will enter swimmers and relay teams using the FINA rankings as the entry time for seeding purposes. Where no valid time information is recorded in the FINA rankings, the swimmer or relay team will be entered with no time. (BL 9.3.6.6)

1.3 Team Officials

Each Federation shall be allowed to include in its delegation Team Officials (coaches, managers, trainers, chaperons, etc.) in a number dependent upon the number of competitors entering and participating in accordance with the following:

Individuals who are serving as Team Officials (coaches, managers, chaperons, etc.) cannot serve as Technical Meet Officials.



2. <u>Accreditation</u>

2.1 General Principles for Accreditation

The purpose of accreditation is to authorise people by confirming their roles at the 15th FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) and providing them the rights to have privileges and appropriate access to functional areas to perform their duties.

The procedure of accreditation ensures appropriate security in the functional zones and arrears of operation.

Accreditation ensures that only the appropriately qualified and eligible people are entitled to participate in or perform official functions at the Championships and used to keep unauthorised people out of such areas, therefore accreditation is not to be granted in lieu of a "free pass" or "event ticket".

The teams representing the FINA member National Federations are entitled to receive accreditation for all eligible athletes competing at the Championships, including the team officials. The team officials are defined as persons whose presence is essential to the administration of an NF's delegation and for the technical and medical support of the athletes competing at the Championships.

National Federations are to note the number of Team Officials (coaches, managers, chaperons, etc.) allowed as detailed in section 1.3. The quotas are not transferable from one category to another.

Concerning NF Representatives, the President and the General Secretary (as specified on the FINA website) will be entitled to a free accreditation. (This cannot be transferred to any other person).

National Federations sponsors cannot be accredited during the Championships.

2.2 Additional Accreditations

National Teams whose number of officials exceed the prescribed quota may request Additional Accreditations.

A fee of USD 150 will be charged for approved additional accreditation passes for individuals registered under the "Team Official" category that exceed the Team Official quota. Any other individual registered under the NF Representative category will be charged a fee of USD 150 USD for their accreditation. NF Representatives are NOT included in Team Official quotas. The additional accreditations are invoiced by and to be settled with the Organising Committee.

FINA has final approval for all additional Team Officials and NF Representative Accreditation's requests that have been registered through the FINA GMS by the registration deadline.



2.3 Venue Access Zones

In order to ensure secure operation and facilitating movements and function of people at the venue performing specific roles during the Championships there will be areas with restricted and additional access control.

The following accesses will be given to the persons depending on their function:

The Federation is entirely responsible for registering the participants with their correct function and role, so that the correct accreditation will be issued.

No accreditations will be changed or re-printed after the registration deadline or/and during the event.



2.4 Loss of Accreditation

In case the individual accreditation badge is stolen or lost, the bearer should immediately report to the nearest security personnel from the Abu Dhabi 2021 OC. A penalty fee may be charged for the reproduction of lost accreditation badges.

3. <u>Training Venues</u>

The information on available facilities for training prior and during the days of the Championships will be communicated in due time.

4. <u>Team Leaders' Meeting</u>

The Team Leaders' Meeting will be organized on **<u>Tuesday</u>**, **14**th **<u>December 2021</u>**, the place and time will be communicated in due course.</u>

Participation is mandatory for all National Federations (a roll-call will be made). Failing to do so will result in a fine of <u>100 Swiss Francs</u>. (GR 7.1)

The Team Leaders' Meeting will cover all aspects about the execution of the 15th FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) competitions and include the following issues:

- Pre-Competition procedures
- Competition procedures
- Post-competition procedures

At the meeting Team Leaders must check all the given information and the spelling of the athlete's name (first name, last name, date of birth, etc.). No corrections or changes will be allowed after the Team Leaders' Meeting. Withdrawals after the Team Leaders' Meeting will be fined according to FINA Rules. Relevant invoices will be addressed to the NF by FINA after the event.



5. Entering Abu Dhabi, UAE - Visa Assistance

Immigration & visa matters

Passports of <u>every person</u> entering UAE must be valid <u>at least 6 months</u> from date of entry.

Visa Upon Arrival

Certain nationalities will receive a visa upon arrival and do not need to apply beforehand. The duration for visa upon arrival will be either 30 or 90 days (Cont. to the next page).

Special Entry Permit

For all other countries, the OC will provide a Special Entry Permit free of charge. Participants will not need to apply for a visa at the embassy.

In order to receive the Special Entry Permit, the registration of all participants must be duly completed in the FINA GMS by the deadline of <u>2nd November 2021</u>. Furthermore, a special form will be distributed that must be completed and sent back at <u>nf@fina-abudhabi2021.com by the deadline. Details of the information required to apply</u> for the Special Entry Permit are listed in appendix A "Special entry Permit" however <u>please note this is NOT the form to be completed.</u>

<u>Team Delegates must ensure to carry the passport that was used for the registration and special entry permit application.</u>

Customs Clearance

The UAE has strict regulations regarding the importing of goods, particularly food, medical items, filming equipment and radios. Due to local regulation the import of specific meat types and beverages might be restricted/prohibited.

Teams are required to submit lists of food, list of Medication*, radio frequencies and professional filming equipment they are planning to bring to the UAE through the NSF Liaison Team at <u>nf@fina-abudhabi2021.com</u> by using the forms provided at the end of this document. See appendices B-E.

Deadline: <u>30th November 2021</u>

For any items not included in the customs clearance forms, we suggest all teams to liaise with the LOC NSF Liaison Team **before their departure for the UAE** at <u>nf@fina-abudhabi2021.com</u>

6. <u>Travel to the UAE</u>

Abu Dhabi International Airport is the second largest airport in the UAE, with three operational passenger terminals, and dominated by Etihad Airways, which is the United Arab Emirates' national carrier and second largest in the UAE after Emirates. More than 30 airlines offer service to over 120 destinations in more than 60 countries. The airport is located 30km from the city centre and is 12.7km from Yas Island.

Alternatively, Dubai International Airport can be used as an arrival point of entry in the United Arab Emirates. Being the world's busiest airport by international passenger traffic, it can add value by connecting even more points on the globe to the final destination in Abu-Dhabi. The airport is located 130 KM (1 hour and 15 minutes' drive) from Yas Island. The Abu Dhabi 2021 OC will provide transfers from/to Dubai International Airport, if necessary.



7. Travel & Accommodation Assistance (the subsidy)

FINA and Abu Dhabi 2021 OC will provide Travel & Accommodation Assistance (The Subsidy) to the National Federations participating at the FINA Swimming Championships (25m) 2021. Detailed information including the Subsidy terms & conditions and deadlines will be provided in a separate communication to each National Federation, along with the Travel & Accommodation Assistance Form.

8. <u>Accommodation</u>

The accommodation shall be booked through FINA GMS following this link: <u>https://data.fina.org</u> observing the specific deadlines. FINA GMS which includes accommodation reservations and bookings, will be available from **16th August 2021**.
